

2.2.1 CLOSING CEREMONY AND GALA

Day: 14 July

Time: **9.30pm**

Place Palau Sant Jordi, at Artistic competition area

Concept: The Closing Ceremony will take place during the Artistic session on Sunday afternoon and

includes the official Closing Ceremony and Artistic Gala.

In accordance with requirements of World Skate Protocol Guide

Produced by: **Focus,** under the direction of Hansel Cereza, with contributions by Ricard Planiol.

Duration: One-hour duration.

How to get to Palau Sant Jordi:

Access is only allowed with tickets for the afternoon session of Artistic.

There are no ticket sales for the Closing Ceremony.

Official transport vs. official hotels:

Delegations staying in official hotels will have WRG2019 transport at their disposal (check at hotel counter for scheduled timetable to Closing Ceremony).

Delegations staying in non-official hotels must travel by their own means, see page. 34 "How to get to Olympic Ring/Palau Sant Jordi", which provides more details on public transport options.

2.2.2 AWARD CEREMONIES

The Award Ceremonies will be held in accordance with the World Skate Protocol Guide.

Medallists must wear their Ceremony uniform.

The Award Ceremonies will be held after the end of each competition, according to the competition schedule of each sport.

The hoisting of flags will be done virtually, with all the positions on the winners' podium projected on the venue screens. The medallists will be positioned in such a way as to allow for a good view of the screens and, therefore, hoisting of their national flags.

The medallists will receive a medal, see section 3.10.2, and a reproduction of Will, the tournament mascot, see section 3.10.3.

All the participants of the WRG2019 will receive a Certificate of Participation, to be delivered at the beginning of the competitions at the Main Accreditation and Information Centre (MAIC).



3. COMPETITION

3.1 LOCATION

Competition Tents Zone

- The competition tent Zone can be found on the top part of the race tracks.
- All the tents will be rightfully marked with the flag of each country

Parking

- Parking is not allowed on top of the race tracks where the tent zone is.
- Parking is not allowed on the lower part of el C/ del Foc (St)

Restaurant

You can find a restaurant 200 meters away from the race tracks, and a food Truck which is located in the area of the Olympic Ring (Roller Land)

3.2 GENERAL RULES

- We ask all the teams and participants to follow strictly the timetables provided. Delays which are not responsibility of the organization itself will not be considered.
- Athletes can be disqualified if they do not follow the rules and normative of WS
- Smoking is not allowed inside the sporting facilities
- No drinks but water are allowed inside the sporting facility
- Bib numbers are required to enter the racing track
- The volunteer's orders should be followed in both access and field of play areas in order to smooth out the processes of the competition.

3.3 MEETINGS

The delegates who want to access the meetings in Palau Sant Jordi have to enter the venue through the access gate which is next to the parking zone M. To enter the venue, delegates must enter in groups and with the right accreditation
