2.1 CEREMONIES

2.2.1 CLOSING CEREMONY AND GALA

Day: **14 July**

Time: 9.30pm

Place **Palau Sant Jordi, at Artistic competition area**

Concept: The Closing Ceremony will take place during the Artistic session on Sunday afternoon and includes the official Closing Ceremony and the Artistic Gala.

In accordance with World Skate Protocol Guide requirements

Produced by: **Focus**, under the direction of Hansel Cereza, with contributions by Ricard Planiol.

Duration: One-hour duration.

How to access Palau Sant Jordi?

Access is only allowed with tickets for the afternoon session of Artistic.

There are no ticket sales for the Closing Ceremony.

Official transport vs. official hotels:

Delegations staying in official hotels will have WRG2019 transportation services (check at your hotel counter for the scheduled timetable for the Closing Ceremony).

Delegations staying in non-official hotels must travel by their own means, see page. 34 "How to get to Olympic Ring/Palau Sant Jordi", which provides more details on public transportation available.

2.2.1 AWARD CEREMONIES

The Award Ceremonies will be held in accordance with the World Skate Protocol Guide.

Medallists must wear their Ceremony uniform.

The Award Ceremonies will be held at the end of each competition, according to the competition schedule of each sport.

The hoisting of flags will be done virtually, with all the positions on the winners' podium projected on the venue screens. The medallists will be positioned in such a way as to allow for a good view of the screens and, therefore, hoisting of their national flags.

The medalists will receive a medal, see section 3.10.2, and a reproduction of Will, the tournament mascot, see section 3.10.3.

All the participants of the WRG2019 will receive a Certificate of Participation, which will be delivered at the beginning of the competitions in the Main Accreditation and Information Centre (MAIC).

3. COMPETITION

3.1. LOCATION

Parc Montjuïc – Passeig del Migdia de Barcelona.

- The National Federations tents are located at the top of the competition zone. Each country will have its tent marked by its flag and country name.
- Parking is not allowed in the upper area of the competition zone.
- Smoking is not allowed in the sport areas.
- A food-truck and a restaurant can be found 200 meters away from the Olympic Ring (Roller Land)



3.2. General Rules

3.2.1 OFFICIAL TRAININGS

It is essential that before starting the official training, all athletes in their respective training schedules pass through the Participant Service Tent, next to the National Federations tent zone. In order to perform the technical inspection of each participant's material (leather jumpsuit or protections, full-face helmet with the two bib numbers attached and Longboard implement, inline skates or luge).

During training sessions, athletes can leave their equipment in the tent area, as there will be security.

3.2.2 COMPETITION

- It is mandatory to carry the transponder in order to participate in competition.
- Athletes must wear the two bib numbers on both sides of their helmet, in order to train and compete.
- An athlete can be disqualified if he does not comply with current WS regulations, if he/she is out of the Time Trial cut of DH Racing or Cross, if he/she is disqualified in the DH Racing or Cross, or if the Technical Level Committee of WRG-WS determines that the athlete is a danger to himself and the other participants.
- When the athlete is eliminated it is essential that he/she pass through the Participant Service Tent to return the transponder. We recommend to not wait until the last day, because if transponder is lost or damaged, the deposit will not be returned.
- The price of the chips is € 100 each, in case of loss they will be deducted from the deposit, and if the deposit is less, the rest will be charged.
- The volunteer's orders should be followed in both access and field of play areas in order to smooth out the processes of the competition.

3.2.2 AWARD CEREMONIES

Athletes who have won the Time Trial, DH Racing Final or DH Cross must be available at the specific time in the awards area (Finish Line).

3.3. MEETINGS

- **The Opening Meeting and Presentation of the World Championship** is scheduled for July 4th at 3:00 pm (only team leaders and delegates) at Palau Sant Jordi.
- It is important to attend the Riders meeting on the 4th of July for all the technical explanations of training and generic competition.
- To access Palau Sant Jordi meetings, delegates will have to go to the box, next to the parking "M". In order to gain access to the Palau Sant Jordi, the attendees will enter as a group and must carry their accreditation.
